

GREAT LAKES UNITY REGION (Policy updated May 2019)

SCHOLARSHIPS and GRANTS

1. GLR shall offer scholarships as funding is available for Unity Classes toward becoming a Certified Spiritual Educator, Licensed Unity Teacher, or Unity Minister.
2. GLR will consider grants or loans for member ministries requesting assistance with transitional, conflict resolution services, or assistance transporting youth to a Rally
3. Anyone applying for a scholarship or grant must be an active member of the Great Lakes Region. Refer to the Great Lakes Region Bylaws for definition of active member.
4. Applicants for educational scholarships must be functioning under the leadership of an Ordained or Licensed Unity Minister, or a UWM-recognized Spiritual Leader.
5. Applicants for educational scholarships are eligible for one scholarship or tuition award per calendar year.
6. A completed application form must be mailed or emailed by the appropriate application date. The application form must be accompanied by an email of support from your Unity minister.
7. If an individual is turned down for a scholarship they will be notified in writing as to the reason why.

GLR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM

GLR awards scholarships and tuition aid to members of our region who are seeking accreditation as Unity ministers, licensed teachers, or spiritual educators. Scholarships are based on individual need and the availability of scholarship funds. Tuition assistance is awarded for on-campus sessions and is contingent on completion of classes in a timely manner.

- Anyone applying for a scholarship or tuition award must be an active member or member ministry of the Great Lakes Unity Region Conference (GLURC). Refer to GLURC bylaws for definition of active member or member ministry.
- Applicants are eligible for one scholarship or tuition award per calendar year.
- Completed application is to be mailed or emailed, accompanied by an email of support

from your Unity minister.
