Event Definitions

Regional

Hosted by the Regional Team. All of the chapters in the Region are invited.

Area-Wide Events (A.W.E.)

Hosted by one or more Chapters. All Chapters in the Sub-Region are invited.

Community Events

Hosted by one or more Chapters. Five or more chapters in a 3-hour driving radius are invited.

Chapter/Local Events

Hosted by a local Chapter or Church. Five or less local Chapters/Churches are invited.

Age Requirements

Uniteens

In order to attend a regional Uniteen retreat, Uniteens must be in 6th-8th grades or equivalent, with a minimum age of 11 and a maximum age of 14.

Youth of Unity

In order to attend a Regional, Area-Wide or Community YOU event, YOUer's must be in grades 9th-12th grades or equivalent, with a minimum age of 14 and a maximum age of 19; *or, if no longer in high school, a maximum age of 18.*

Attendance Requirements

Uniteens

In order to attend a regional Uniteen retreat, Uniteens must have attended at least 3 Uniteen Sunday lessons in the 2 months preceding registration. No exceptions.

Youth of Unity

In order to attend a Regional, Area-Wide or Community YOU event, YOUer's must maintain 50% attendance at Chapter lessons. No exceptions.

Service Hour Requirements

Uniteens

In order to attend a regional Uniteen retreat, Uniteens must have at least 2 hours of service for the Fall Unitreat and an additional 4 hours for the Spring Unitreat Service hours are not required for Area-Wide or Community Events.

Youth of Unity

In order to attend a regional YOU event, YOUer's must have at least 12 hours of service for the Fall Retreat and an additional 12 hours for the Annual Rally. Service hours are not required for Area-Wide or Community Events.

Ability to Honor Agreements

All participants must be able to honor heart agreements, function in a group setting and MUST attend the entire weekend from check-in thru Closing Ceremony. Youth with special challenges requiring close,
